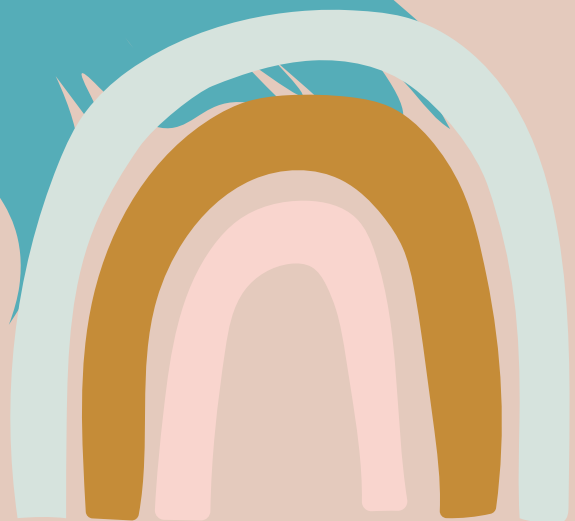

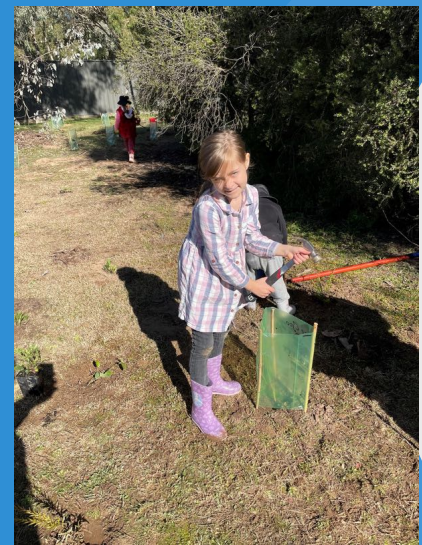
We have a new felt display board which each day has the season, months, day, date, weather and flag - as well as shapes and colours. We discuss this each morning when the children arrive.
